Robby Tulus pioneered the credit union movement in Indonesia, and more recently is engaged in initiating and establishing community-based consumer co-operatives in the country;

He spent 10 years with the ICA, first as Senior Policy Advisor and subsequently Regional Director for Asia and the Pacific;

Before that he was Asia region Director of the Canadian Co-operative Association, training specialist of the Asian Confederation of Credit Unions and Managing Director the Credit Union Counseling Office of Indonesia.

He was also special envoy of ICA following the Tsunami which devastated Aceh and Sri Lanka, and was subsequently hired by ADB as Co-op Specialist to help co-op reconstruction in Aceh, and also facilitated the establishment of the Aceh International School of Microfinance (AISMIF) with Syiah Kuala University in Banda Aceh.
